

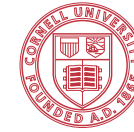

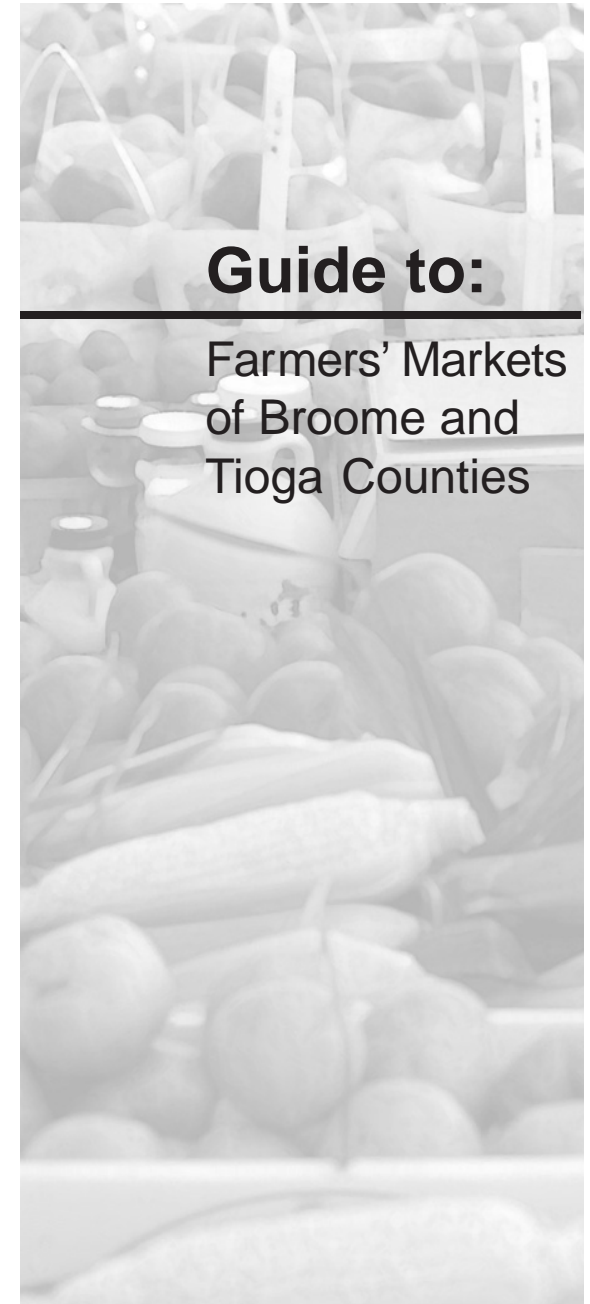

### Why Shop at a Farmer's Market?

- it supports the local economy
- you can meet the farmers that grow your food
- there's higher nutritional content in fresh-picked produce
- the prices are favorable to consumers and the money goes directly to the farmer
- you can get new recipes and learn more about local food
- it's a kid-friendly environment
- you get the freshest, highest quality produce available

### Tips:

- bring a shopping bag (use a cloth bag or reuse old bags to reduce waste)
- have cash (especially change and small bills) or checks. Most vendors do not accept credit cards.
- if you will be out for a while, bring a cooler to keep produce in until it can be refrigerated.
- walk through the whole market before making purchases.
- if you're purchasing bulk produce for canning or freezing, come early or place an advance order.
- get preparation tips and recipes from the growers themselves!
- try new things!
